"BRICK OF HONOR"

at Lincoln's Veterans Memorial Garden



A "Brick of Honor" is available to all Veterans, living or deceased, who are serving honorably or have received an Honorable or General discharge. The bricks are displayed in the Veterans Memorial Garden in Antelope Park, Lincoln, NE. The proceeds from bricks sales will go to improvements and programs in the Veterans Memorial Garden.

Once placed in the Garden, all bricks become the property of the City of Lincoln and the City reserves the right to verify the information. Only one name per form will be accepted. An annual dedication of newly placed bricks is held on the second Saturday in June at 11:00 a.m. Bricks may not be in place for the dedication if this form is received after March 31st of that year.
